Under her leadership, our House, steeped in centuries of history, was infused with a new, contemporary spirit.

Inspired by the world of perfumery, her other great passion, it was she who introduced the first transparent bottle for a rosé Champagne in 1947.

This bold move was inspired by her wish to showcase the purity and finesse of this exceptional wine by revealing its delicate and elegant colour.



ABOUT THE CUVÉE

"An ode to today's way of connecting and celebrating".

Today, the Champagne House is giving the Cuvée "Suzanne Gosset" - a thoughtful and timeless tribute created by Albert in honour of his mother - a new lease of life. First introduced with the 1985 "Brut Rosé", this cuvée was presented in a bottle adorned with roses, a flower Suzanne loved, and a symbol of her natural grace and beauty.

Like its namesake, the Cuvée "Suzanne Gosset" embodies the art of effortless, elegant hospitality.

This confident, contemporary Champagne is perfect for tasteful social occasions, from after-work drinks to cocktail parties. This radiant cuvée also pairs beautifully with a wide range of dishes, from classic favourites to bold culinary creations.

A true celebration of the way we socialise today, it turns any occasion into an unforgettable moment of enjoyment and connection.

A CONTEMPORARY CUVÉE

THE STYLE

This wine is remarkable for its balance of freshness and maturity. It combines power and fruitiness with exceptional aromatic persistence while preserving a wonderful fluidity. A distinctive expression of the Gosset style, it is a masterful fusion of elegance and character.

TECHNICAL DATA

This rosé Champagne includes a high proportion of Chardonnay (65%), bringing freshness and finesse to the blend, complemented by Meunier (17%) and Pinot Noir (11%), which contribute structure and fruitiness, and a touch of red wine (7%) from Cumières, adding some clean, ripe fruit flavours. Sourced from a remarkable variety of crus, including Aÿ, Bar-sur-Aube, Bouzy, Courmas, Cumières, Montgenost, Passy-sur-Marne, Tauxières and Vandières, the base wines for this cuvée were aged for nine months on the lees of their first fermentation before being blended and bottled in the spring of 2018. The resulting cuvée was then aged on the lees from its second fermentation for at least 60 months. After disgorgement, the bottles were returned to the cellars to rest for over a year, allowing the wine to harmoniously integrate the 11 g/l dosage, carefully measured to achieve a perfect balance.

TASTING NOTES

APPEARANCE: A lovely bright hue with coppery tints that reflect the Champagne's long ageing process.

NOSE: The first nose reveals aromas of red stone fruits, such as cherries and plums. As the wine gently

aerates, it releases more intense aromas of ripe pink grapefruit and white peaches.

PALATE: Clean and fresh on entry, the palate unfolds with an enveloping texture, elegantly balancing tension and

smooth fruitiness. The long-lasting finish reveals fresh citrus aromas, set off by a subtle touch of minerality.

THE PACKAGING

This new edition marks the celebrated return of the transparent bottle for a rosé Champagne, created by Suzanne in 1947. Intended to show off the cuvée's unique colour, the bottle reveals a coppery hue infused with lovely bright highlights that reflects the wine's long ageing and exceptional character. The bottle has been given a contemporary makeover with an elegant new packaging design.

Suzanne Gosset's handwritten signature graces the hallmark "necklace medallion" label, set in "biscuit" colour and black tones. Inspired by the world of luxury jewellery, this "necklace medallion" label, so named by Albert Gosset, evokes sophistication and timelessness while embodying the heritage of the Champagne House.

The bottle is presented in an elegant gift box that echoes the design of the packaging. As a nod to the family's history, Suzanne's portrait adorns the wire cage's cap, gracefully watching over this tribute to her legacy.

THE GOSSET CHAMPAGNE HOUSE

Jean Gosset was already harvesting grapes from the family vineyards in Aÿ back in the 15th century, in 1484, at the dawn of the Renaissance and before Christopher Colombus had discovered America! In 1531, Jean Gosset held the title of "Lord of Aÿ and Mareuil" and historical records show that the Gosset cellars were located next to those of King François I.

Founded in Aÿ in 1584 by Pierre Gosset, Champagne Gosset is the oldest Wine House in Champagne. Independent and family-owned, it embodies a deep-rooted heritage that has been carefully preserved and passed down from generation to generation. Each of its Champagnes is a testament to time-honoured craftsmanship and a relentless pursuit of excellence, with time itself as its most important ally.

The Gosset style is defined by a vibrant mineral freshness combined with deep vinosity. This distinctive style, the result of a unique vinification process, preserves the grapes' original aromatic freshness while endowing the wines with exceptional potential for ageing on their lees. The result is elegant, complex Champagnes of remarkable depth. Champagne Gosset expertly crafts rosé Champagne with finesse and elegance. The Cuvée Suzanne Gosset is the perfect example of this approach. It is a unique expression in which expertise, innovation and the art of bringing out all the aromatic subtleties of a rosé Champagne come together in harmony.

Inspired by the legacy of their predecessors, the cellar masters, guardians of the house style, create wines of depth and finesse with remarkable precision and an unmistakable signature. These unique creations embody a preserved heritage, where every detail conveys the timeless vision of an exceptional Champagne House.
