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« LA RÉSERVE DE LA FAMILLE » : CHAMPAGNE GOSSET SHARES ITS HERITAGE

The oldest Wine House in Champagne is introducing 'La Réserve de la Famille' to connoisseurs of rare wines, with a limited-production Champagne, recently disgorged after nearly three decades of cellar ageing and available exclusively in magnums.

FROM FAMILY RESERVE TO SHARED HERITAGE

Since 1584, Champagne Gosset has preserved and passed down its winemaking heritage and savoir-faire. Year after year, generation after generation, a few bottles of its finest cuvées have therefore been laid down in its cellars – not to preserve a historical record, but to perpetuate a style, inspire reflection, carry forward a vision... and offer the promise of exceptional drinking experiences yet to come.

La Réserve de la Famille was born out of this tradition. With this cuvée, Champagne Gosset is sharing a part of its heritage. 'La Réserve de la Famille' was originally intended purely for family use: to train the palate, pass on the Gosset style, serve as a touchstone for future custodians of its heritage, and accompany special family occasions for generations to come. To share this piece of its family history more widely, Champagne Gosset has decided to make some of these rare bottles available to fine wine lovers, collectors and friends of 'Maison Gosset'.



CELEBRIS 1998 MAGNUM

The first edition of 'La Réserve de la Famille' is the Gosset Celebris 1998, originally released in 2006. Fewer than 500 magnums were laid down in the Gosset cellars for an exceptionally long period of ageing – more than a quarter of a century – before disgorgement.

Ideally suited to extended ageing, the magnum reflects a principle central to the Gosset philosophy: giving the wine the time it needs. 'La Réserve de la Famille' Gosset Celebris 1998 was never intended simply for the present, but to enrich and carry forward Champagne Gosset's heritage. This unique Champagne fully embodies the spirit of Gosset Celebris, Gosset's rare and iconic collection – it is a 'cuvée d'exception' conceived as a tribute to time and outstanding vintages.

More than a provenance, 'La Réserve de la Famille' expresses the fundamental values that have shaped Champagne Gosset's history: transmission, a long-term approach and a dedication to excellence. This Champagne is intended for discerning food and wine lovers seeking exclusive wines that tell a story as much as they capture a vintage.

Since 1584, Champagne Gosset's history has been shaped by an enduring belief: a fine wine can be appreciated in a moment, but the style of a House reveals itself over time.



ABOUT GOSSET CELEBRIS

Launched in 1995, Gosset Celebris is a range of rare Champagne wines. With just 10 Vintage, 2 Blanc de Blancs and 6 Rosé releases in more than 30 years, it is produced in strictly limited quantities and embodies the quintessence of the Gosset style. True 'wines for laying down' ("vins de garde"), the Gosset Celebris cuvées are crafted with exceptional precision and undergo extended ageing in the Gosset cellars. They embody Champagne Gosset's dedication to crafting Grands Vins and its commitment to extended ageing. Gosset Celebris are not only 'cuvées de prestige' but also 'cuvées d'exception'.

ABOUT CHAMPAGNE GOSSET

Located in Épernay, Champagne Gosset is the oldest Wine House in Champagne. Its origins date back to 1584, when Pierre Gosset, lord and alderman of Aÿ, established a négociant business. A century earlier, in 1484, the family was already producing wines from its vineyard in Aÿ. The Gosset name thus carries seven centuries of winemaking history, including more than four centuries during which Champagne Gosset has refined and passed on its savoir-faire in crafting Champagne wines of distinctive character and unique style.
